
Purpose/Function

11/2/09	MGPTF – Resources deployed to Lee Mathson Middle School (SSCI, ARCC, CYO, MACSA)
11/4/09	Held Internal Team Meeting
11/5/09	Superintendent Briefed (ARUSD)
11/10/09	Community Meeting Held (Lee Mathson Middle School) * 300 residents in attendance
11/16/09	Protocol Debrief (MGPTF, SNI, and ARUSD) 30-60-90 day work plan reviewed
